## Interior Window Measuring Guide

GUIDELINES FOR Measure each window individually, as size variances are common.
A PERFECT FIT Record width first and then height. Round down to the nearest $1 / 16^{\prime \prime}$.
Measure width from left to right, height from top to bottom, using a steel tape measure.
DO NOT USE A CLOTH MEASURING TAPE.

1. Measure Width: Measure the inside width of window frame in three places where you will install the interior window.

Record narrowest measurement.*
2. Measure Height: Measure the inside height from the top of window frame to top of sill in three places where you will install the interior window. Record shortest measurement.*

Interior windows are made to the size ordered to fit inside your opening.

* If the difference between the largest measurement and the smallest measurement is greater than $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ in height or $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ in width, do not order these windows.


## Helpful Hints:

- Make sure your interior blinds are mounted on the outside of your window frame.
- If you have crank style windows, ensure your window has sufficient depth to accommodate the interior windows.
